### **Athletic Director: Mark McGuire -**

- Fall sports underway, already have had picture days at H.S. & M.S.
- Athletic passes are online  
Keeping reserve seats from last year deadline has passed but there are still seats available.  
10 game passes (student pass, adult pass)  
Family passes available all home games and 2 reserved seats for football games  
Passes only good for regular season event, tournaments are not included
- Final forms - 2nd year for fall season, 642 fall season athletes (HS/MS) - all done online except p.3-4 papers must be turned in. Sudden Cardiac Arrest training has to be signed off by players, parents, coaches, trainers are instructing students where the AED machines are. 2 new portable ones have been purchased for X country, would still like to have some in the park by the tennis courts.
- School will be offering heart screening through M-Corp \$75 on Oct. 13 (no school)
- New uniforms were purchased for girls soccer, X country, M.S. Volleyball team
- Volleyball sectionals will be Oct. 16, Districts Oct. 24, 28
