- 28 teams, \$11,060 registration fee, scoreboard is now paid off, so money minus expenses will come back to boosters. We also made \$7117 on gate fees, \$5384.36 on concessions, \$1205 on t-shirt sales.
- Expenses include \$150 for printing, \$3045 for officials, \$2007 for hospitality room (Alesci’s), \$1168 for awards, \$1120 to ABL for shirts.
- Suggestion for next year – include hospitality room on the Booster’s Sign Up Genius – too hard for families of athletes to run and watch their child.
