11-14-2022 Solon Athletic Boosters Meeting

A regular meeting of the Solon Athletic Boosters started at 6:30 PM led by Rob Farley.

Athletic director's report: Not at meeting. No report. Boys soccer coach resigned.

Secretary's report: Minutes have been posted to the website.

Treasurer's report: The Spirit Store continues to be a strong revenue generator for the Booster Club, as it was #1 in revenue for the month. Membership Revenue trickled in during the month, which appears to be final dues from fall sports and the beginning of dues starting to come in for the winter sports. My sense is we will get a bump in membership in November.

The donation from the track program was money the team collected for the purchase of their indoor track mats, this was voted last meeting. Spirit store inventory continues to be an expense, which goes together with the significant revenue. The club also paid the bill for the fall sports programs. The club spent money on various sports teams in October, most of which was for indoor track running mats to support the boys and girls track programs. Hockey warm ups were also purchased this month, cameras for the baseball team, along with crowd control barriers that are used in the parking lot.

The total assets as of October 31, 2022 is \$151,788.26, ; this represents a decrease in assets of \$10,965.45 from September 2022. For comparison, at this point last year (October 2021), we had \$103,366.78 in assets. October 2022 resembled October 2021 as a month where we spent more funds on the student athletes than we collected.

President's report: \$1000 was donated from the mattress fundraiser sale back in October. Was not a well-attended event due to great weather, Solon Community event and a Guardians game at the same time. But "will take \$1,000 any day." Gift cards are being sent to students from DiBellas for Athlete of the Week. We hosted a playoff football game on Friday and earned about \$800 from parking. Getting LED lights installed in stadium. Pat Walsh, new hockey coach, is here.

Pat Walsh: For me it has been "hockey is life" since I was a little kid. I'm trying to rebuild the program here at Solon. Put Solon back in the "red" division. It all starts with everyone coming together. We play home games at Gilmour rink 2.
